The FESSH Academy is a residential course of 4 days planned for 21-24 April 2021 in Budapest, Hungary.

It will be a mixture of lectures, case based discussions and practical sessions. It is aimed at trainees in the early years of hand surgery and is intended to provide a solid foundation of knowledge and treatment rationale upon which a young hand surgeon can build for the future. Although it is not primarily designed for the EBHS exam, prospective candidates will find many aspects of the course useful. The carefully selected faculty is composed of senior surgeons from across Europe, all with international reputations and proven track records in teaching and lecturing.
